

QUESTIONS FROM THE GRANT WORKSHOP – 3/1/18

Q: Are receipts required to be submitted?

A: No, receipts are not required to be submitted

Q: How much of the grant money may go to administrative costs?

A: 15% of the grant may fund administrative costs for the organization

Q: What if the organization has submitted a separate grant for the same program?

A: The Youth Activity Grant may be awarded even if the program is also being funded by another grant

Q: What if the program will be taking place in two different districts? For example, if the youth in the program are from Goshen, Oroshi, and Visalia?

A: If you are bringing the youth from Goshen and Oroshi into Visalia, the district would be where the youth are from. We have funded organizations before, such as AYSO, which is a Visalia league, but the youth were from Goshen and therefore the grant was awarded for District 4.

Q: What is the difference between program costs and administrative costs? Can salaries be funded through the grant?

A: Salaries may be funded under the administrative cost limitation, which is 15%. Program costs would be the materials used to make the program happen. They would be supplies and things of that nature.

Q: What is the grant's definition of 'youth'?

A: The grant defines youth as a young person enrolled in either elementary, middle, or high school. Thus, they may be 18 and still considered youth as long as they are enrolled in high school.

Q: Is the Action Plan document available online?

A: Yes, all the grant documents are available online

Q: What if you don't need all of the money in the grant? For example, if you are awarded \$5,000 and you only need \$3,500 to run the program?

A: Either the money will be returned to the County if unspent, or it is the hope of the Youth Commission that this would allow the organization to expand the funded program and incorporate more youth.
